- 3. Attend at least one sustainability program throughout fall semester back on Ohio State's campus.
- 4. Attend one end-of-semester group meeting (on December 1 at 5:30pm, Location TBA), to revisit information learned through the semester as student leaders in sustainability at Ohio State.
