

 were awarded to students across North America.




Categories

A Unique Program

What makes the TransCanada Scholarship program unique?

- Evaluation criteria focus on leaderships skills and community involvement, not solely academic performance.
- Students receive financial support directly, not through a post-secondary tuition account, so they can remove whatever financial barriers to education they may have.
- There is no third-party organization involved, so when students contact us, they're contacting TransCanada employees who can answer any questions they might have.

How to Apply

Students can answer five quick questions at <u>TCscholarships.com</u> to see if they pre-qualify for a TransCanada Scholarship. Applications re-open on January 14, 2019 and close May 17, 2019.

Pre-qualification Questions:

- 1. Are you enrolled in a post-secondary institution?
- 2. What is your permanent address or the home community you identify with?
- 3. Are you a citizen or permanent resident of the U.S., Canada or Mexico?
- 4. Are you a dependent of an employee, contractor or consultant who is employed by TransCanada? (dependents of TransCanada employees, contractors or consultants are not eligible to apply for these scholarships)
- 5. What is your email address?


